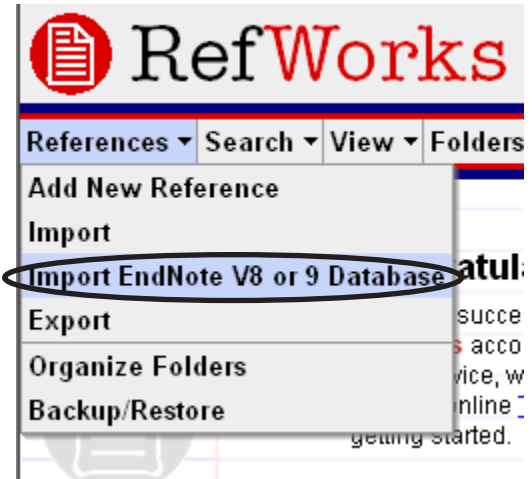




Transferring EndNote V8 or 9 Libraries to RefWorks

1. Once you have created your RefWorks account, mouse over *References*, located in the RefWorks toolbar.
2. If you are using EndNote V8 or V9, select *Import EndNote V8 or 9 Database*. If you are using an earlier or later version of EndNote, see the URL at the bottom of this page.
3. Select the EndNote Library you wish to import by using the *Browse* button, located at the right side of the screen.
4. Click *Import*.
5. Click *View Last Imported Folder*.
6. The references from your EndNote library will display on the screen.
